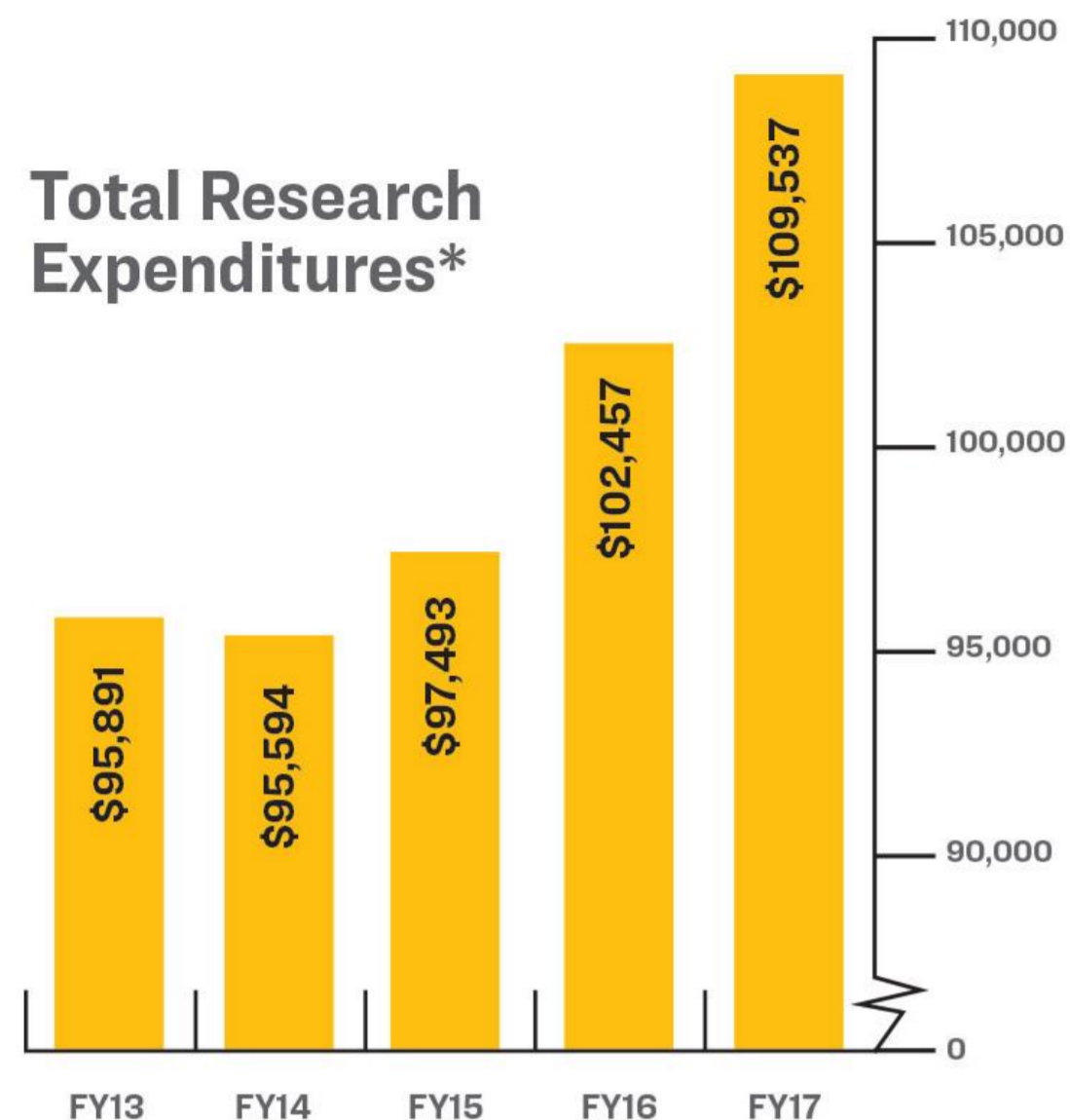

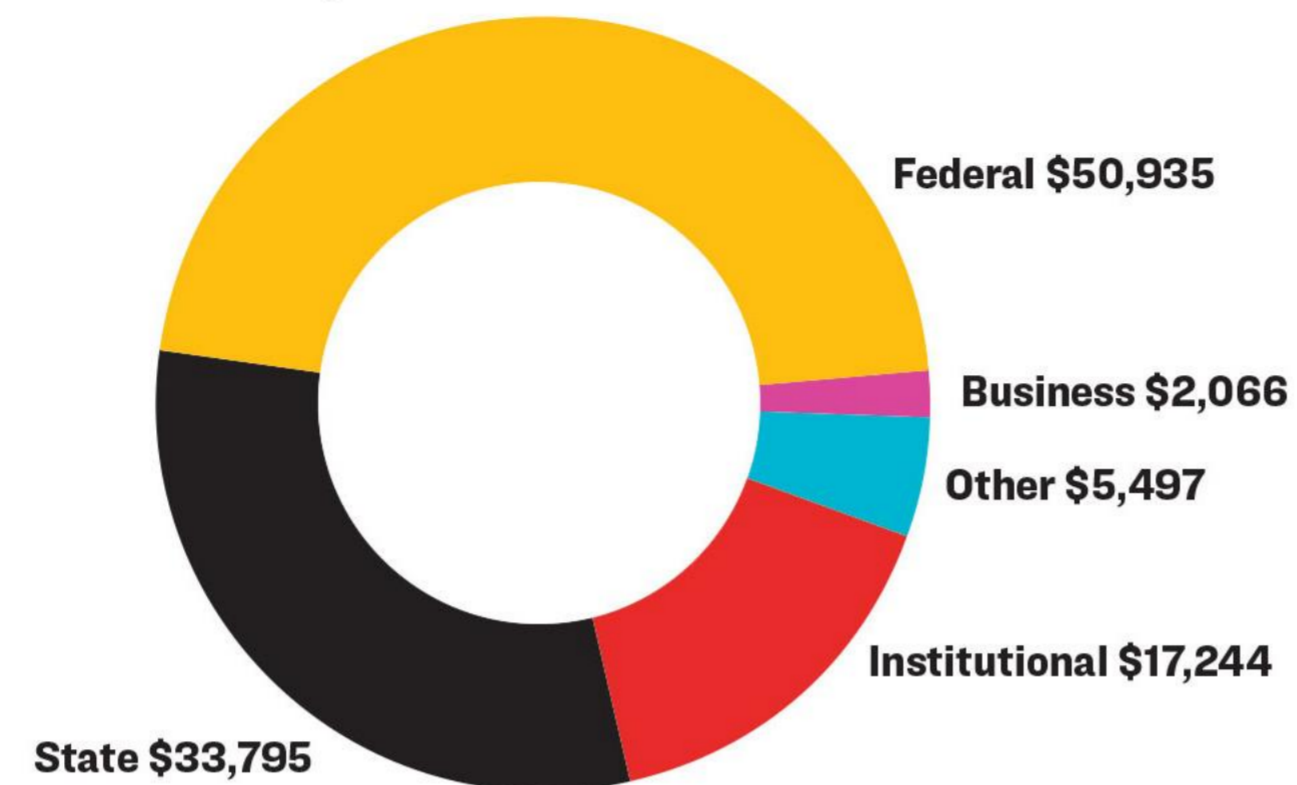


**Total Research Expenditures\***

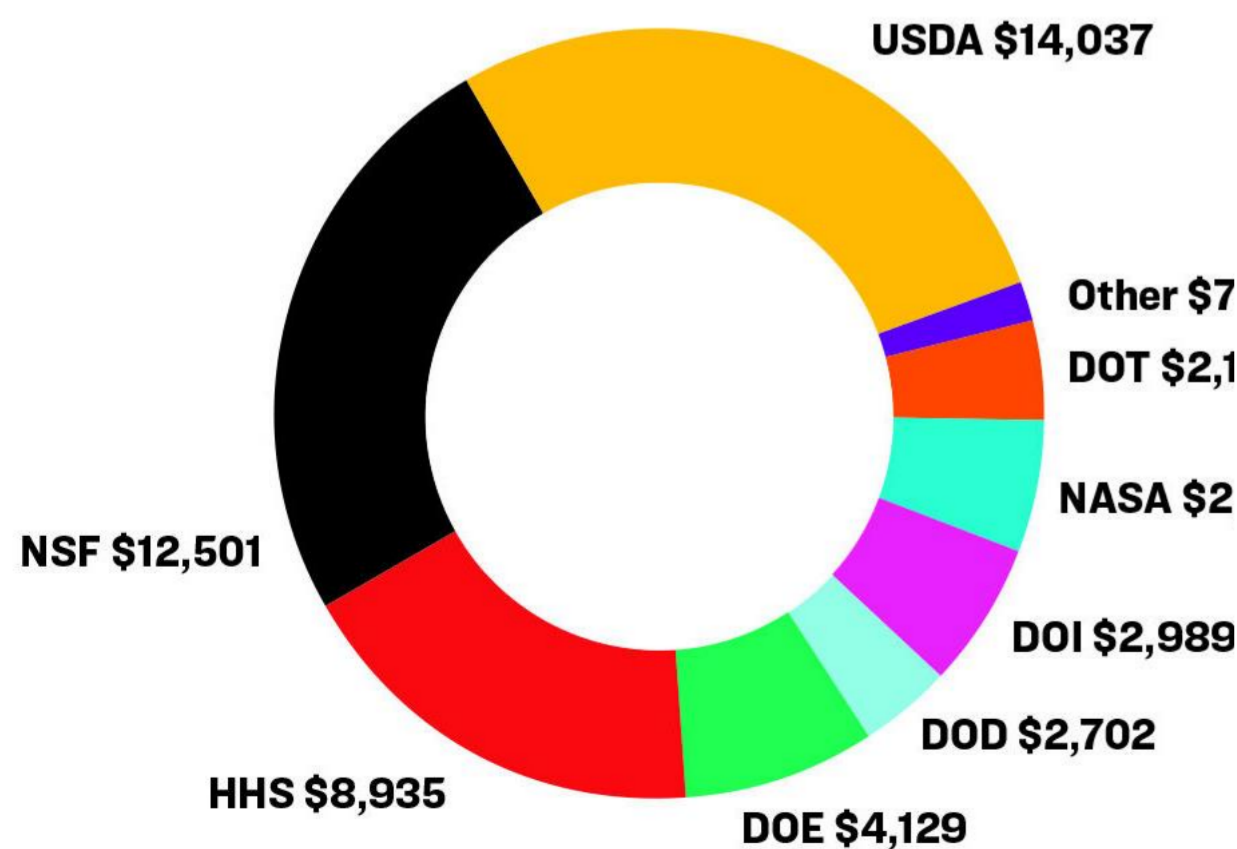


# INNOVATE PROGRESS BY THE NUMBERS

## RESEARCH & SCHOLARSHIP WITH IMPACT

- I Increasing annual research expenditures
- I Implementing Teaching Assistantship compensation change
- I Emphasizing that faculty excellence includes research, teaching and service

### RESEARCH & SCHOLARSHIP

- \$20 million EPSCoR grant from NSF focused on trout genetics, sagebrush
- \$1.28 million in USDA grants for rangeland research
- \$5 million NIH grants for multiple projects: antibiotic resistance, vaccines, malaria
- Scholarship & creative activity: archaeology, humanities, music, etc.
